Meaning: When things are uncertain, rely on your core values or inner guidance.

Usage: Otto uses this in confusing or tricky times to reassure others to stay true.

7. "Leaders lift others."

Meaning: True leadership means helping others rise.

Usage: Otto reminds himself and others of this when someone needs support.

8. "The journey teaches what the map cannot."

Meaning: Experience brings lessons no plan can predict.

Usage: Otto says this after adventures, emphasizing the value of lived wisdom.
